Time Off Request Calendar Statutory Holiday Updates

The following Statutory Holiday adjustments are now available in the Time Off Request Calendar based on individual provincial legislation.

New Brunswick Family Day

Family Day is now selected (by default) as a holiday in New Brunswick for 2022 and beyond.

Nunavut Day

Nunavut Day has been removed as a statutory holiday for 2022 and beyond.

Quebec Easter Weekend

Customers operating in Quebec have the option to observe the holiday on Friday (Good Friday) or Monday (Easter Monday). To enable this option:

- Easter (QC) has been added on the Friday for Quebec in the Time Off Request Calendar and is selected as a statutory holiday.
